### Unit - Me Letters - Capitals

### Reading & Writing

### Math

We've been practicing our math skills during calendar every day, including counting, patterning, adding, and graphing. We also practice our counting, comparing, adding, and subtracting skills when we do our Math Works program each day. We also spent time talking about shapes, colors, and sizes. We've been reviewing and using all those math terms we learned last week, too. We've also been practicing counting backwards from 10. Please practice this at home, as well, because the more we practice, the better we get!

### Science & Social Studies
